C.4.	<p>Here again, letters of agreement are needed and, l.o.a.'s which are contained in plan reviewed by the RAC, need to be updated.</p>	
J.10.a.	<p>Preselected radiological sampling and monitoring points for the plume exposure pathway are not on the operations map submitted.</p>	
J.12.	<p>A letter of agreement from the Red Cross is needed and should include the "registering and monitoring of evacuees" as a Red Cross responsibility.</p>	
N.2.a.	<p>Reference should be "page 90".</p>
