
Thank you for your letter of May 29 concerning deficiencies in HVAC equipment manufactured by the Bahnson Company.

A thorough investigation reveals that Florida Power Corporation has never done business with the Bahnson Company nor with Flakt. We are, however, doing an in-depth review of our purchase orders to determine if either organization was used as a subcontractor to companies who did supply our HVAC equipment. This research will take several weeks. We are extremely confident that no material from either of these organizations was supplied to CR #3; however, the completion of this research will provide 100 percent assurance.

Florida Power Corporation continues to be totally committed to a high degree of assurance that the health and safety of the public are being protected and are in no way compromised by our activities at Crystal River Unit 3.
