## NRC Public Meeting on WHR Exemption

### NEI Questions:

1. Can the NRC provide clarification on entry criteria by which a station could submit for the exemption to 10CFR26.205(d)(1)-(7) as provided by the subject letter?
2. Stations that may need to deviate from the 3/28/2020 exemption letter intend to include it in the email request along with the appropriate justification. Is this the correct understanding of the request provision in the 3/28/2020 letter?
3. Stations intend on starting the 60-day period exemption allowance time upon implementation of the exemption? Does this align with the intent of the exemption letter?
4. What circumstances would the use of waivers as described in 10CFR26.207 be permitted under the alternate work hour rules provided by the exemption letter?
