

Gentlemen:

Your letter of August 29, 1984, (ØCNAØ88428) requested that AP&L respond within 30 days of receipt, to the questions presented in its attached Safety Evaluation Report (SER) pertaining to reactor coolant pump seal integrity following a loss of offsite power. Due to the number of questions presented and the depth of review necessary to comprehensively address each, an additional six weeks will be necessary to prepare our response. The need for additional time to respond to the SER, and similar SERs forwarded to other licensees, was discussed in conversations held between individuals within your staff and Mr. Jim Taylor of B&W during the week of September 24, 1984.
