As discussed at the June 19, 1984 hearing, the various documents comprising the Louisiana Peacetime Radiological Emergency Response Plan, River Bend attachment and various implementation documents, are now available for inspection, at the office of the Louisiana Nuclear Energy Division (LNED), Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), 4845 Jamestown Avenue, Baton Rouge, Louisiana during normal working hours. 
