
Dear Mr. Schwencer:

In response to a request from the Commission, Philadelphia Electric Company hereby certifies that Limerick Generating Station Unit 1 has been designed, constructed and tested in a manner which complies with the applicable parts of 10CFR Parts 20, 50, 51 and 100, with the exception of specific exemptions which have been requested pursuant to Section 50.12 of the Commission's regulations. These specific exemption requests are detailed in the reference letters.

Limerick's compliance with the Commission's regulations is discussed in detail in the License Application and its associated documents, including the Limerick Generating Station FSAR, EROL, EQR, FPER, EP, DAR, PRA, SARA and Technical Specifications.




