



Dear Mr. Hunter:

This letter withdraws the potential 10CFR50.55(e) concerning I-Beam fabrication discrepancies identified at Wolf Creek Generating Station (WCGS). This matter was initially reported on December 1, 1983, and supplemental information was provided in the Reference.

The Architect/Engineer has completed engineering evaluations of the concerns described in the Reference. Based on the results of these evaluations, Kansas Gas and Electric Company (KG&E) has determined that the conditions would not have adversely affected the safety of operations of WCGS had they gone uncorrected. Therefore, KG&E has concluded that this matter is not reportable pursuant to 10CFR50.55(e).
