

REVISED RESPONSE TO A NOTICE OF VIOLATION

In our April 21, 1988 response to the Notice of Violation associated with NRC Inspection Report Nos 50-338/87-38 and 50-339/87-38, we indicated that Station Administrative Procedure, ADM 16.2, Reportable Occurrences/Licensee Event Reports, had been revised to require a qualified Shift Technical Advisor to review each reportable event and oversee the preparation of the Licensee Event Report (LER).

This letter is to notify you that we have since revised the process for LER preparation and have currently assigned Licensing Department personnel to oversee the actual preparation of the LER after the reportability review is complete. This method of LER preparation has proven to be effective in submitting quality LERs.
