
Dear Mr. Youngblood:

Dear Mr. Keefe:

In accordance with 10 CFR Part 961, enclosed herewith are five (5) copies of the Contract for Disposal of Spent Nuclear Fuel and/or High-Level Radioactive Waste, signed on behalf of Texas Utilities Generating Company. Upon execution by the Department of Energy, please return one fully executed copy of the contract to TUGCO.

This contract is being executed because of the statutory requirement for TUGCO to have such an agreement with DOE in place prior to receiving an Operating License for the Comanche Peak Steam Electric Station. By the execution of this contract TUGCO does not waive any of its rights to seek, before DOE or the Courts, changes to the Final Rule or the Standard Contract. TUGCO specifically objects to those portions of the Standard Contract for which we requested deviations in our letter of February 2, 1984, but which were subsequently denied in your reply dated April 18, 1984. TUGCO does not, however, limit its objections to those issues.
