Shoreham Low Power Proceeding

Dear Judge Miller:

In reviewing the August 16, 1984 transcript containing the closing arguments of the parties, we discovered that the arguments of counsel for both LILCO and the NRC had been substantially mistranscribed. LILCO notified counsel for the Licensing Board, NRC, and Suffolk County of this problem and attempted to notify counsel for New York State. Both the NRC and Suffolk County have agreed to the submittal of a corrected copy of the transcript to the Board and to the parties who have actively participated in the Low Power Proceeding.

LILCO attempted to reconstruct its own argument and worked with Bob Perlis, counsel for the NRC, to reconstruct his argument. Ms. Letsche, counsel for Suffolk County, whose argument appears for the most part to have been properly transcribed, has not had the opportunity to review the limited corrections made by LILCO to her argument and reserves the right to submit her own corrections.


