David Reich (previously scheduled)



After our conversation today, I realized that Mr. Moore, whom we noticed for a deposition earlier, answered that he was not aware of the hydrogen combustion/explosion on March 28. However, he was aware of in-core thermocouple temperatures in excess of 2500 degrees on March 28, as a result of an assignment he received from Parsippany corporate management to collect information at the site. Therefore, TMIA wishes to depose him on his information gathering on the in-core thermocouple data and the persons to whom he distributed that information. I have scheduled Mr. Moore for the morning of September 28.
