
This letter is to confirm an August 20, 1984, telephone discussion between L. Narrows of Region I and N. P. Dyck of PSE&G.

In previous correspondence we stated that Bechtel, our Architect Engineer, had identified the purchase orders that could contain material similar in type to that supplied by Ray Miller, Inc. Bechtel contacted the suppliers and had received replies from all except two affirming that no material from Ray Miller, Inc., had been supplied.

Bechtel has completed a field investigation of the documentation from these two suppliers and found no indication of Ray Miller, Inc., material being supplied.

Should any additional information be desired, we will be pleased to discuss it further with you.
