AFFIDAVIT OF VINCENT S. BOYER
SENIOR VICE PRESIDENT, NUCLEAR POWER
PHILADELPHIA ELECTRIC COMPANY

Vincent S. Boyer being first duly sworn according to law deposes
and states:

1. My name is Vincent S. Boyer. I am Senior Vice President,
Nuclear Power, of Philadelphia Electric Company. In this position I
have overall responsibility for the nuclear power activities of the
Company including Limerick Generating Station.

2. I have reviewed my affidavit of September 4, 1984 filed in
response to the Board's requirements (Tr 12,285). At this time, the
estimated readiness of Limerick I for fuel load is the end of the first
week of October, 1984.

3. Applicant's estimated fuel loading date is based upon the current
completion status of plant construction, miscellaneous testing and startup
activities, as determined at monthly Project Review Meetings, weekly
Integrated Schedule Review Meetings, weekly Project Startup Test Results
Review Meetings, and the closing of items recently identified in NRC
Inspection Reports.

4. Construction of the plant is complete. Testing of plant systems, together with internal review and documentation of the test program, required for fuel load will be completed by October 1, 1984. NRC Region I has been working cooperatively to complete its review of test results on an expedited basis.

5. The Staff of the Office of Nuclear Reactor Regulation and NRC Region I visited the plant and conducted their Operational Readiness reviews of the facility on September 19, 1984 and September 24, 1984, respectively.

6. In summary, I believe Limerick I will be ready to receive the low power license by the end of the first week of October, 1984.


