HONEYWELL METROPOLIS – READY IDLE CONDITION

Current Status:

- The site continues to receive, sample, and ship ore concentrates.
- The Metropolis UF6 processing operation is currently shut down.
- UF6 has been removed from the process equipment.
- Anhydrous Hydrofluoric Acid (HF) has been removed from the site. There is no inventory of HF contained in any of the process equipment.
- Exception of Sulfuric Acid, all other bulk chemicals are removed from storage. The acid is used to neutralize pond liquors.
- The Liquid Hydrogen tank has been emptied and removed from the site.

HONEYWELL METROPOLIS – READY IDLE CONDITION

Reorganized staffing as follows:

- Approximately 6 operators remain on site for sampling activities.
- Approximately 20 salary remain on site for management, compliance, and operating leadership.
- Approximately **60 contractors** remain on site for required maintenance and pond remediation activities.
- Honeywell has completed the license renewal effort. The new NRC license was approved on March 24, 2020 for a 40-year term.
- Security activity to maintain requirements of security orders.
- Health physics monitoring and bioassay program, as required, to support sampling plant activity.
- Calcium Fluoride pond remediation project is in progress.
- Emergency response activity commensurate with hazards as identified.
