REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

On November 8, 1984, Joint Intervenors filed a motion to reopen the record in this proceeding and a companion motion seeking a protective order to shield the identity of their affiants. Applicant's answer is due November 23 and the Staff's answer is due November 28.


