On October 18, 1984, the bypass switches of the Leakage Detection System on the Reactor Water Cleanup (RWC), the Residual Heat Removal (RHR), and the Reactor Core Isolation Cooling (RCIC) Systems were placed in bypass for maintenance troubleshooting. This violated Technical Specification 3.3.2 due to exceeding the one hour time limit the switches are allowed to be in bypass.

On October 18, 1984, between 0757 hours and 0945 hours, the bypass switches of the Leakage Detection System on the Reactor Water Cleanup, the Residual Heat Removal and the Reactor Core Isolation Cooling Systems were placed in bypass to troubleshoot an inadvertent Reactor Water Cleanup containment isolation which occurred on October 17, 1984.

In order to comply with Technical Specification 3.3.2, the Leak Detection System can only be bypassed for a minimum of one hour without isolating the affected system.

The operator had erroneously assumed that the bypass switches could be placed in bypass for up to two hours according to Technical Specification Table 3.3.2-1 note (b). This only applies if there is another operable channel in the same system to monitor the parameters. Because of the assumption, an action statement entrance was not realized, therefore, an LCO was not written.

The error was corrected immediately upon discovery. A change has been initiated to the Alarm Response Instructions for the bypass alarms of these leak detection switches to make the operator aware of the one hour limit of Technical Specification 3.3.2.


