I asked John to identify his responsibilities at the Plant. John said his title was Manager of Technical Support and that he reported to Tom Greene, Assistant General Manager, Support. He said his ^{organizational} responsibilities included handling procedures, PRB secretary, plant performance, quality control, Reactor Engineering and IASAC. He said he was a member of the PRB and that this included document review/generation as well as license or procedure changes.

I asked John if he could recall a letter which dealt with the issue of allowing a project to proceed due to the potential benefit in one area versus increased risk in another. He did not recall such a letter but said he could, and would, state that one should not pick the requirements which are to be met and others to be ignored—that all requirements must be met.

I asked about DC cards on the loss of power event in May. He felt there may be only one DC which was issued and that it covered the event in general.

I asked about the function of the PRB and the review and resolution of disagreements. He said he felt it was difficult to be dissenting in the PRB. ~~PRB~~ He noted that George Sockhold, when present, was a forceful individual who shared his opinions openly.
