Pacific Gas and Electric has maintained a high standard for qualification and continued requalification of its Diablo Canyon licensed operators. The current requalification program ensures established standards are met concerning operator knowledge, changes in plant design and procedures, participation in operating activities, including operating evolutions in the control room and plant, as well as training sessions on the onsite plant specific simulator.

All Unit 1 licensed personnel have participated in power ascension activities to power levels greater than 20% thermal power and in low power physics testing. They were also involved in or observed initial core loading.

PGandE requests that the NRC issue dual unit operating licenses to all Unit 1 licensed personnel upon successful completion of the unit differences examination. In addition, PGandE requests that Diablo Canyon be recognized as a multi-unit licensed plant as specified in NUREG-1021 and that all future License/Certification examinations be for dual unit qualification.
