BVPS Physical Security Plan (PSP)

Enclosed is Revision 27 to Issue 4 of the Beaver Valley Power Station (BVPS) Physical Security Plan (PSP) (Base Plan and Training & Qualification Plan). These changes are being submitted based on the recent revision to 10 CFR 73.55 and/or the criteria described in NRC Generic Letter 95-08. Revision 27 changes include the following:

1. Base Plan Chapters 5 and 11 now contain a revised policy on reactor containment access via portals within a Vital Area. This is in accordance with the recent deletion of the 10 CFR 73.55(d)(8) requirement for specific access control for containment.
2. Base Plan Chapter 5 is revised to delete specific reference to the type of construction used for the battery rooms since the battery rooms are located within a larger Vital Area.
3. Base Plan Chapter 5 revises the statements regarding the intent to post, with a security force member, only those Vital Area barrier portals that are not within another Vital Area.
4. Base Plan Chapter 13 was upgraded to reflect the use of longer record retention periods in accordance with 10 CFR 73.55 and 73.70 requirements.
5. The Training and Qualification Plan (TQP) matrix has been revised regarding the training requirements for unarmed watchmen.
6. The TQP for Officer Certification has been modified to allow for acceptance of documented training and qualification of security personnel from other licensed nuclear facilities provided the training meets specified criteria as described in 10 CFR Part 73 Appendix B.


7. Additional TQP training tasks have been added for the other personnel classifications.
8. Minor administrative and/or editorial changes were made to the Base and Training & Qualification Plans.

These changes have been reviewed and judged not to decrease the safeguards effectiveness of the BVPS Physical Security Plan. Accordingly, this revision is being submitted in accordance with 10 CFR 50.54(p)(2).
