Dear Administrative Judges:

It has come to my attention that there is a factual discrepancy between the Federal Emergency Management Agency's prefiled testimony and the affidavit previously filed in support of summary disposition of Sunflower Alliances' Contention M.

The affidavit of Robert O. Shapiro states in paragraph 25 on page 10 that "The Lake County plan does not indicate any intent to provide a county monitoring system." On page 4 of the prefiled testimony Mr. Shapiro states "Lake County will utilize information from a fixed monitoring system it plans to install and the State of Ohio monitoring teams (Lake PERP, Section I, p. 112-115)."

Since these statements appear to be mutually exclusive, after discussion with the Staff's counsel, we felt compelled to direct the Board and parties attention to them.
