In response to your letters dated October 3, 1984 and December 19, 1984, we hereby inform you that as of this date we have achieved complete implementation of our Emergency Plan for the Reactor Facility of the University of Virginia. The University's Reactor Safety Committee met on March 27, 1985 and approved the Emergency Plan Implementing Procedures (EPIP's). These procedures were presented for study to the entire Reactor Facility Staff during a requalification meeting held today. Practice drills are anticipated with some drills to be held in the near future, in conjunction with NRC observers from the NRC Region II Office.

We are remitting under separate cover a copy of the U.Va. EPIP's that is to be kept at the Bethesda, Maryland NRC Emergency Center. A separate copy is also being sent to the NRC Region II Office, for future reference during emergency drills or actual emergency conditions.
