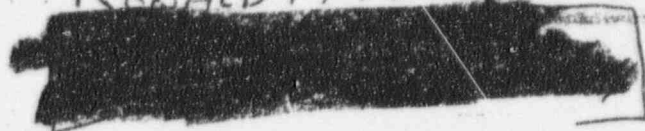

Pass a resolution to be forwarded to state and federal officials demanding a moratorium on nuclear plant construction.

Press for congressional action; write, phone and telegraph.

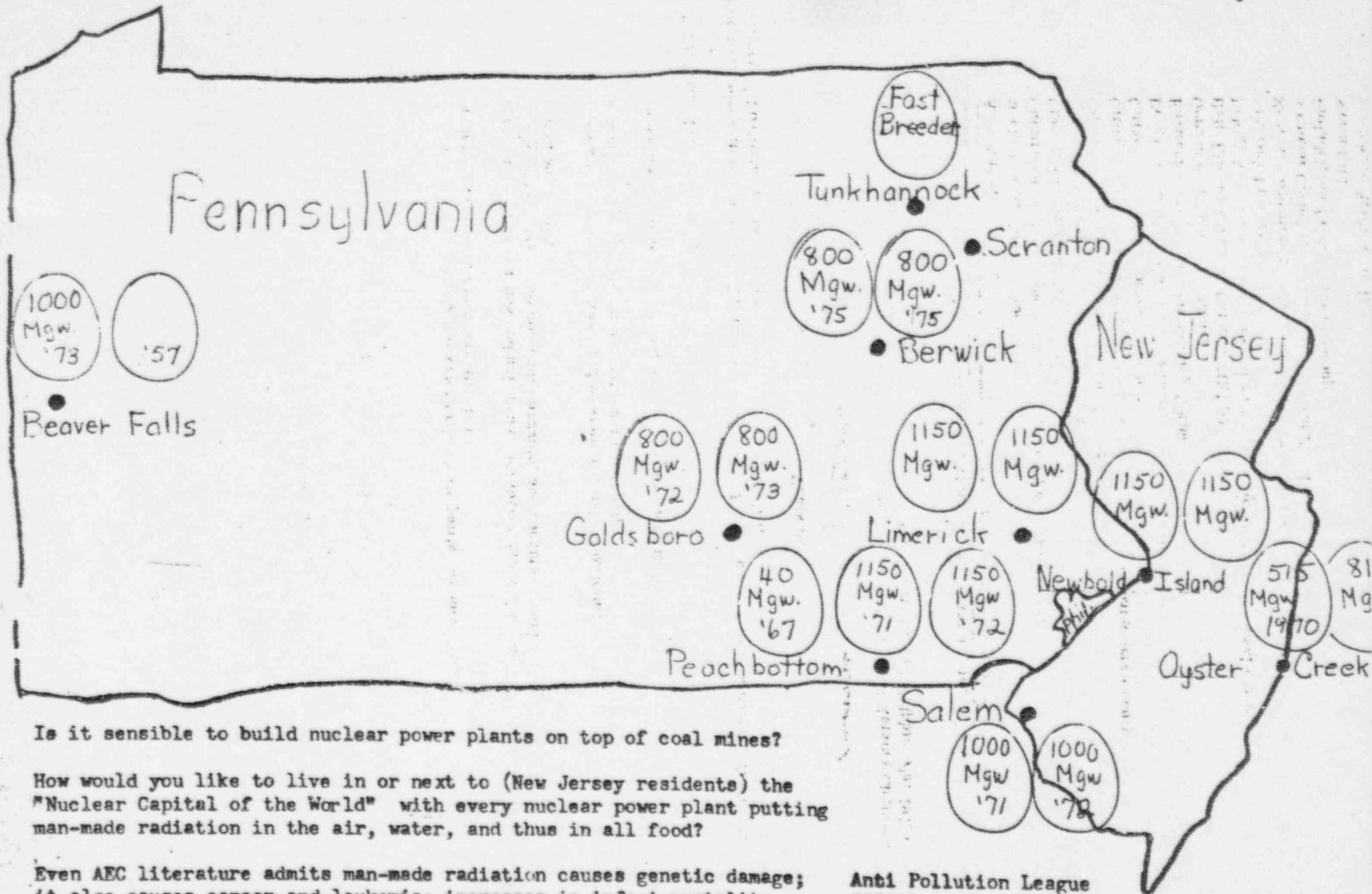
