As requested in Administrative Letter (AL) 96-01, Operator Licensing National Examination Schedule, enclosed is the voluntary response concerning the estimated number of candidates to be examined during scheduled examination visits.

The proposed Operator Licensing Examination Schedule data, in Part A of the enclosed NRC Form 536, reflects the anticipated examination dates for fiscal years 1996 through 1999. Only the August examination date is reflected for each year, since it is currently anticipated that none of the February site visits reflected in the National Examination Schedule attached to AL 96-01 will be necessary.


