Millstone Nuclear Power Station, Unit No. 2
I&E Inspection Report 50-336/85-01

During the week of January 7-11, 1985, NRC Region I conducted an audit of work performed in response to I&E Bulletins 79-02, 79-04, 79-07, and 79-14 at Millstone Unit No. 2.

On January 11, 1985, Mr. Varela conducted an exit interview summarizing activities performed that week by himself and consultants from EG&G Idaho, Inc. In his concluding statements, Mr. Varela requested a written response to the following items:

- 1) Provide the statistical basis to develop the confidence factor for the 79-02 inspections at Millstone Unit No. 2.
- 2) Provide the quantity of anchor bolts that were tested in each safety related system.
- 3) Provide the total quantity of anchor bolts installed in each safety related system.

While Northeast Nuclear Energy Company (NNECO) has not yet received the subject inspection report, we are providing, at this time, our schedule for responding to these items.


Based on our review of all previous submittals and available project documentation, NNECO has concluded that, while this information exists in our files, it is not in the requested format. In view of the substantial effort required to support Mr. Varela's request, NNECO expects to complete the subject data collations and provide the requested information on or about April 1, 1985.
