I. MANAGEMENT ACTIONS

- A. Three (3) OPPD employees tested positive during Random Drug and Alcohol Testing. All three individuals began an outpatient Rehabilitation Program, signed Re-Entry Agreements and returned to work.
- B. Due to an administrative deficiency, the test screening cutoff for marijuana was the 10 CFR 26 limit of 100 ng/ml from March 14, 1995 through July 24, 1995. Subsequent testing has used the OPPD 50 ng/ml administrative cutoff point. Based on statistical analysis of historical data, it is unlikely that any positive results would have been revealed by testing to the lower cutoff point during this period. Personnel associated with administration of the OPPD Fitness-for-Duty Program have been made aware of this condition, and further actions to prevent recurrence have been established.
