Gentlemen:

In our letter of July 29, 1983 (1CAN078308) we proposed to construct a seismic, partially tornado protected, condensate storage tank (CST). Since that time, the design of this tank has been discussed and agreed upon by AP&L and the NRC staff. As all the main points of the tank design are now fixed, Mr. Vissing of your staff has requested that AP&L submit a schedule for the completion of the CST. This schedule is attached. The exact dates of each construction phase may vary. However, the tank will be complete and ready for testing by the beginning of the upcoming seventh refueling outage. Upon the completion of the final testing, which must be performed during an outage, the new CST will be operable.
