APPLICANT'S MOTION FOR AN ENLARGEMENT OF THE
PAGE LIMIT FOR ITS RESPONSIVE BRIEF

In its October 29, 1984 Memorandum (unpublished), the Atomic Safety and Licensing Appeal Board ordered that Applicant file a single brief in response to the three separate appeals of Limerick Ecology Action ("LEA"), Air and Water Pollution Patrol ("AWPP") and Friends of the Earth ("FOE"). Pursuant to 10 C.F.R. §2.762(e), Applicant moves for an enlargement of the number of pages permitted for its responsive brief.

The enlargement is required because of the number of legal issues and factual matters raised by Limerick Ecology Action in several different subject areas in its 48 page brief. While the briefs of AWPP and LEA are not that lengthy, each raises a number of legal and factual issues which require a reply. Applicant has sufficiently progressed in its response that it can state an enlargement of the page limit to 115 pages would be sufficient to permit


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adequate treatment of the three appeals. Of course, every effort will be made to keep Applicant's brief as concise as possible.
