This letter will confirm that Louisiana Power & Light Co. has reviewed files, gathered during the NRC Staff review of Waterford 3, which have been requested for release under the Freedom of Information Act.

This review was conducted during the week of December 10, 1984 and was for the purpose of determining if the subject files contained information of a proprietary or confidential nature and which should be withheld from disclosure under 10 CFR 2.790.

Louisiana Power & Light Co. has completed its review of the subject files and has not identified any documents which Louisiana Power & Light Co. intends to request be withheld per 10 CFR 2.790.

It is our understanding that the NRC Staff will, prior to disclosure of the subject files, review for and delete material related to personnel, medical and similar files, the disclosure of which would constitute an unwarranted invasion of personal privacy per 10 CFR 2.790(a)(6).
