IST PROGRAM SAFETY EVALUATION

Gentlemen:

On April 16, 1992, a conference call was held with the NRC staff and representatives of Georgia Power Company (GPC) to discuss Appendix A of the NRC's safety evaluation (SE), dated December 10, 1991, on GPC's second 10-year Inspection Interval IST Program. The SE concluded the IST program is acceptable for implementation, provided the items identified in Appendix A are addressed within the specified timeframe.

During the conference call, GPC representatives briefly discussed the items shown in Tables 1, 2, and 3 as provided in GPC's letter dated April 16, 1992. In addition, GPC proposed a schedule for addressing each item. The proposed schedule is as follows:

1. A response and/or revised relief request for the Table 1 and Table 2 items will be submitted by June 5, 1992. GPC will implement the appropriate IST program changes, as required, within 6 months of receipt of an NRC response.
2. A response and/or revised relief request for the Table 3 items will be submitted by November 17, 1992. GPC will implement the appropriate program changes or alternative actions, as required, within 6 months of receipt of an NRC response.

The NRC staff indicated agreement with the proposed schedule presented by GPC. GPC indicated agreement with the staff recommendations and will provide the submittals and program changes as indicated above.


