This letter provides supplemental information in support of the subject technical specification request as discussed with the Callaway Project Manager on June 16, 1992.

The Safety Evaluation which was transmitted as Attachment 2 of the referenced letter discussed on page 2, paragraph 2 that "the qualified life of affected components will be re-evaluated based on 106°F continuous temperature". There are six transmitters which were re-evaluated due to the proposed 2°F temperature increase (from 104°F to 106°F). The increase in temperature resulted in a decrease of 11 months in the qualified life for these transmitters. The Callaway EQ Program will be updated with this information upon approval of the subject technical specification request.
