Dear Mr. Knighton:

By way of the referenced letter Louisiana Power & Light Co. responded to NUREG 0737 Supplement 1 including a plan for phased implementation and integration of the emergency response facilities for Waterford 3. The April 15, 1983 letter specified a December 31, 1984 completion date for the permanent EOF with the qualifier that the schedule was still under evaluation. This letter is to inform you of a change in the schedule for completion of the permanent EOF.

As specified in the submittal, LP&L defined fully functional with respect to the permanent EOF as completing all action concerning structure, instrumentation, procedures, and staff training.

LP&L plans to have the EOF portion of the Training Facility essentially complete by December 31, 1984. However, to establish the EOF as "fully functional" will require an extension of the schedule estimate in our April 15, 1983 letter to a completion date of February 28, 1985.
