Temporary Addendum Four supersedes previously submitted Addenda One, Two and Three (ref. ST-HL-AE-5245, dated December 4, 1995). Temporary Addendum Four is being submitted in accordance with section 10.4 of the Physical Security Plan. None of the changes described in the Physical Security Plan Revision 4A or Temporary Addendum Four represent a lessening of security effectiveness.

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
