
Procedures Generation Package (PGP)

In response to Reference (2), the District has prepared a PGP in accordance with guidance provided by INPO and NUREG-0899, Guidelines for Preparation of Emergency Operating Procedures, dated August, 1982. The purpose of this letter is to submit the Fort Calhoun Station PGP for NRC staff review.

The Fort Calhoun PGP will be utilized to upgrade the existing Emergency Operating Procedures (EOP) and will be maintained as a working document for future revisions to the EOPs. The Administrative Procedures of the Fort Calhoun Station Operating Manual will be revised to stipulate the use of the PGP for upgrading and revising the EOPs.

The EOPs are currently being upgraded in accordance with the Fort Calhoun PGP. Final implementation of the revised EOPs is expected by the end of the 1985 refueling outage.
