Dear Public Information Officer,

In February of 1981 there was a shipment of high-level radioactive material from the Oyster Creek Nuclear Power Plant in Forked River, New Jersey to the Battelle Labs in Ohio. Evidently Battelle Labs was to determine the extent of radioactive degradation and report back to the utility.

In looking through the official public document room at the Ocean County Library in Toms River, I can find no information filed with the NRC about this. I called Battelle in Ohio and they said whatever information would be in the hands of the utility. I called GPU Nuclear and they said they hadn't received any information from Battelle.

Can you tell me if there has been any sort of publicly available report on this, and if so how I might go about obtaining it? I'm also trying to find out when this material will be shipped back to Oyster Creek for storage, or whether it's headed elsewhere.

I would appreciate whatever information you can send me about the condition of this material.
