The Indiana State Board of Health plans on having a program to evaluate the environmental radioactive contamination from the operation of the Marble Hill Nuclear Generating Station.

The State Board has received near complete cooperation from the staff of Public Service Company of Indiana (PSI). Our Radiological Health Laboratory has already split water samples and arrangements have been made to split milk and other samples. We have accompanied PSI staff while setting out TLD's, and they have offered to assist us when we start our own TLD network in 1984. In addition, PSI has complied with all environmental programs under the direction of the Environmental Management Board.
