

Radiological Effluent Technical  
Specifications (RETS)

Gentlemen:

By letter dated December 14, 1984, (ØCNA128413) NRC issued amendments to the ANO-1 and ANO-2 Technical Specifications to incorporate revised Technical Specifications relative to radiological effluents. These revised specifications incorporate the requirements of 10CFR50 Appendix I.

As requested by your letter we are currently preparing revisions to Appendix B Technical Specifications for each unit to delete those items superseded by RETS. In order to avoid potential misinterpretation of appropriate Technical Specification requirements pending completion of this change, administration of the methods and limits of compliance, recordkeeping and reporting for gaseous and liquid effluent monitoring and radiological environmental monitoring will be conducted in accordance with RETS in lieu of corresponding Appendix B specifications.
