Security Plan Revision #16

Due to changes in Organization, Security Systems and Plant Configuration, we have submitted Revision #14 to the Security Plan in October 1983 and Revision #15 in January 1984. We have been in communication with your staff concerning these revisions for several months. Most recently, it was agreed that we would address all of your staff's questions in our latest revision (Revision #16) to the Security Plan. This was documented in your letter August 31, 1984 to me.

Attached is Revision #16 which has been reviewed and is determined to meet the requirement for implementation without prior NRC approval in accordance with 10 CFR 50.54(p). Also attached is a summary of the section of the plan changes and our evaluation of the changes.

We believe that Section 12.5 of the plan which requires all weapons to be tested every 12 months + 3 months is consistent with the flexibility built into other system testing and evaluation criteria and allows us needed operating flexibility. We appreciate your consideration in this matter.
