Relief from ASME Boiler and Pressure Vessel Code
Section XI

In Reference (2) the Omaha Public Power District provided the Commission with the 1983-1993 ISI Program Plan. Reference (3) provided changed pages to the Program Plan. Reference (4) notified the District that relief was granted for the 1983-1993 interval for Class 1, 2 and 3 examinations with interim relief continuing for pump and valve examinations. Reference (5) extended the interim relief for pumps and valves until September 26, 1985.


To facilitate your review of the remaining relief requests, the District hereby submits a complete version of the District's current ISI Program Plan (excluding drawings).
