Dear Mr. Denton:

In compliance with 10 CFR 50.54(f) and in response to Reference 1, LILCO certifies the following:

- a) LILCO has in place and is implementing an Environmental Qualification Program that will satisfy the requirements of 10 CFR 50.49 and Reference 2 condition C(9). It should be noted that certain station modifications, and test and evaluation programs are not complete to date.
- b) LILCO has submitted via References 3 and 4 a justification for continued safe operation pending full qualification of equipment not fully qualified.
- c) All other equipment within the scope of 50.49 is either fully qualified or a justification for continued operation (JCO) has been submitted (via References 3 and 4) pending full qualification.

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
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In reference to IE Bulletin 82-04 and the ten IE Information Notices mentioned in the Generic Letter, please be advised that LILCO has addressed the Bulletin, and Information Notices 82-11, 82-52 and 84-23. We have determined that these do not change the qualification status or JCO for any Shoreham equipment. The remaining seven Information Notices are still under consideration by our engineering staff. To date, no cause for changing any qualification status or JCO has been identified.

The referenced Generic Letter required a response no later than 30 days from the date of issuance (December 27, 1984). My office received the letter on January 16, 1985. Therefore, per discussion between our Mr. N. Lewis and your Mr. R. Caruso, the due date was deferred until February 16, 1985.

We trust this satisfactorily addresses the referenced Generic Letter. If your staff requires additional information, please contact this office.




