

Florida Power and Light Company (FPL) has issued Revision 9 to the Turkey Point Physical Security Plan and has determined that the revision does not decrease the safeguards effectiveness of the plan. Pursuant to 10 CFR 50.54 (p), a report describing the revision and copies PTNPSP-3 through PTNPSP-6 of the plan are enclosed. The report enclosed includes a summary of the changes, a revised list of effective pages and completely retyped copies of Revision 9 of the plan. The plan was completely retyped in order to gain consistent word processing throughout the plan.

The enclosed material contains safeguards information as defined by 10 CFR 73.21; its disclosure to unauthorized individuals is prohibited by Section 147 of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended. Therefore, pursuant to 10 CFR 2.790 (a) (3), the enclosures are exempt from public disclosure.

By copy of this letter, we are forwarding copies of PTNPSP-1 and 2 to the Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Region II.




