SUBJECT: Review of the Revised Monroe County, Michigan Offsite
Radiological Emergency Response (REP) Plan for Fermi II

On January 11, 1985, you requested the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) to provide the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) with a supplemental interim finding confirming the adequacy of the revised Monroe County, Michigan, Emergency Operations Plan dated October 1984. This plan was approved by the Monroe County Board of Commissioners on December 11, 1984.

In a telephone conversation on January 24, 1985, between Dave Matthews of your staff and Craig Wingo of my staff, it was agreed FEMA would provide NRC with a memorandum containing a statement concerning the adequacy of the revised Monroe County plan by March 15, 1985. Further, it was agreed that FEMA Region V would provide a supplemental interim finding to FEMA Headquarters by April 30, and we would provide you with a copy as soon as possible thereafter. This was confirmed to you in my memorandum of February 5, 1985.

The FEMA Region V Assistance Committee (RAC) met on February 21 and 28, 1985 to review the revised Monroe County plan. Based on their review, the RAC concluded there is reasonable assurance that the revised Monroe County plan dated October 1984, is adequate and capable of being implemented in the event of an accident at the Fermi II Nuclear Power Plant. A copy of FEMA Region V's March 1, 1985, memorandum citing the RAC's conclusion is attached.

FEMA Region V appreciates the assistance your office provided concerning the above NRC request. In this regard, FEMA Region V agreed on February 5, 1985 to send your office a memorandum containing a statement as to whether or not there is reasonable assurance that the revised Monroe County, Michigan, Emergency Operations Plan, Appendix 1, Nuclear Facilities Procedures is adequate and capable of being implemented in the event of an accident at the Fermi II Nuclear Power Plant.

The Region V Assistance Committee met on February 21 and 28, 1985 to conduct a review of the above plan as well as the revisions to other plans site specific to Fermi II. The conclusion of the RAC review is there is reasonable assurance this revised Monroe County plan is adequate and capable of being implemented in the event of an accident at the Fermi II Nuclear Power Plant.

FEMA Region V will also submit a supplemental interim finding in support of this position to FEMA Headquarters by April 22, 1985.
