Dear Dr. Markowitz:

By letter dated September 6, 2019 (ADAMS accession number ML20017A308), Hartford Hospital submitted to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) a request for written consent to an indirect license transfer of NRC Materials License No. 06-00253-04. Based on the information provided, the indirect license transfer resulted from a transaction between Hartford Hospital (HH) and Hartford Healthcare Corporation (HHC), which occurred on or about November 1985. Under the terms of the transaction, HH became a wholly owned subsidiary of HHC. We further understand that this transfer did not result in any changes to the licensee name, licensed materials, persons using the licensed material, location of use, or persons responsible for the radiation safety program.

This request was effectively for post-hoc approval of an indirect license transfer that occurred in 1985, without receiving written consent from the Commission as required by 10 CFR 30.34(b)(1). Please note that any future transfers of control must receive prior written consent from the Commission in accordance with 10 CFR 30.34(b)(1).

As more fully detailed in the enclosed Safety Evaluation Report, which documents the NRC staff's review of the request, and in accordance with 10 CFR 30.34, the NRC consents to the transfer. Please note that since this transaction occurred in 1985, no other action is required. Future changes in the licensee's name, licensed use, licensed materials, licensed location, persons responsible for licensed material, or other changes to the corporate organizational structure require submission of a request to amend the license or a request to transfer the license. NRC approval must be received prior to implementation of the proposed change.
