Dear Ms. Ross,

By letter dated February 14, 2020 (Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS) Accession No. ML20054B747) and supplemented by letter dated March 14, 2020 (ADAMS Accession No. ML20093B937), Rio Algom Mining LLC requested a license amendment for editorial and administrative revisions to Source Materials License SUA-1473. As communicated in a phone call to you on March 31, 2020, the NRC staff completed its acceptance review of this amendment request on March 30, 2020 and has found the request acceptable for further detailed technical review.

Please note that staff's technical review may identify technical issues that require staff to request additional information (RAI) from Rio Algom Mining LLC. Staff's review schedule for the issuance of the RAI and the requested license amendment is provided in the table below.
