George/Catherine –

I wanted to reach out to you today and provide you with an update on my compliance with my Confirmatory Order obligations:

1. **NAYGN annual meeting in May has been cancelled**

I was notified on Tuesday (March 31, 2020) by NAYGN that the annual meeting in May, where I was scheduled to present on protected activity, has been cancelled due to the current and expected impact of COVID-19 on travel and the restrictions on group meetings.

NAYGN asked that I schedule a webinar in April on the same topic that would be recorded and then posted to the NAYGN website and social media outlets, as well as distributed through the NAYGN newsletter.

I am hoping that you approve my acceptance of this webinar format so that I can comply with my Confirmatory Order obligations, while making industry presentations in a manner that recognizes the realities of this pandemic. I will reach out to SNC VP Mike Meier (or his designee) to seek his assistance with or contribution to recording a presentation along the lines of the RIC presentation you have seen and reviewed. I will keep you informed.

2. **INPO Quarterly Training Sessions for industry management**

One of my contacts has been speaking to INPO about the potential for me to participate as a speaker at one of the INPO quarterly training sessions for industry management. Although the May/June session was cancelled as a result of COVID-19 issues, I have asked to be considered for either of the two remaining management training courses in 2020. I am not certain of the dates at present, but I will let you know as soon as I have more information.

3. **Future speaking engagements in light of COVID-19**

I will stay in contact with you as I work to identify additional presentation forums. I am hopeful that the NAYGN webinar model may be one that can be replicated.

Thank you for your consideration, and I'd welcome any feedback you have. Hope all is well and you are staying safe and healthy during these uncertain times.
