

NOTIFICATION OF CHANGE IN OPERATOR STATUS

Gentlemen:

Title 10 of the Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) Part 55.25 requires that the NRC be notified within 30 days when the licensee develops a physical or mental condition that causes the licensee to fail to meet the requirements of 10 CFR 55.25. On September 1, 1992, Mr. D. W. Bland, License Number SOP-20773, Docket Number 55-21266, was diagnosed as having supraventricular tachycardia related to an electrophysiological aberrancy. Upon reporting his symptoms, Mr. Bland was restricted from license duties and referred for cardiac evaluation. On the date of diagnosis, the tachycardia was surgically corrected. Mr. Bland's condition will be confirmed corrected within 6 to 8 weeks.
