Subject: Detroit Edison Commitments for Resolving Spent Fuel Pool Issues

This letter is provided in response to the Reference 2 request for Detroit Edison to confirm the commitment to resolve fuel pool-related issues associated with three Deviation Event Reports (DER 95-1021, DER 96-0235, and DER 96-0306).

Detroit Edison confirms that the resolution of all three of these DERs is currently in progress. Our plan is to complete all required actions and internally submit them for closeout before September 27, 1996, the scheduled start of the Fermi 2 Fifth Refueling Outage. In those cases where the DER resolution requires a change to the Fermi 2 Updated Final Safety Analysis Report (UFSAR), an approved Licensing Change Request (LCR) will be part of the completed DER.

The following commitment is made in this letter:

- Complete all required actions for DER 95-1021, DER 96-0235, and DER 96-0306, and internally submit them for closeout before September 27, 1996

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
