Millstone Nuclear Power Station, Unit No. 3
Requested Withdrawal of Proposed Revision to Technical Specifications
Reactivity Controls, Reactor Coolant System,
and Refueling Operations (TAC#83706)

By letter dated May 20, 1992,⁽¹⁾ Northeast Nuclear Energy Company (NNECO) submitted an amendment request to the NRC Staff which would revise the technical specifications of Millstone Unit No. 3. The proposed changes would revise technical specifications dealing with reactivity controls, reactor coolant system, and refueling operations.

The purpose of this letter is to inform the NRC that NNECO has identified additional changes that we believe would be prudent to make to the previously transmitted license amendment request. At this time, we believe that it would be beneficial, for both the NRC and NNECO, to resubmit our previous letter with the new proposed changes incorporated. Therefore, the purpose of this letter is to withdraw our pending license amendment request as discussed with the NRC Staff in an October 26, 1992, conference call.


