SUBJECT: October 1992 Monthly Operating Report (MOR)

Enclosure 1 is the October 1992 MOR for Fort Calhoun Station, Unit No. 1 as required by FCS Technical Specification Section 5.9.1.

Reference 2 submitted the September 1992 MOR for FCS. In Section "D" (Significant Safety Related Maintenance for the Month of September 1992), the report incorrectly stated that lift pressures for pressurizer code safety valves RC-141/142 were lowered to 2350 psia. As shown on the enclosed corrected page (Enclosure 2), the lift pressures for RC-141/142 were reset. The setpoints were lowered to 2350 psia for the Reactor Protective System High Pressure Trip and the Power Operated Relief Valve opening.
