Dear Sir:

By letter of April 4, 1985, Boston Edison proposed an exigent change to Pilgrim Nuclear Power Station (PNPS) Technical Specification 3.7.D.2. The reason for this proposal was the failure of an inboard sample line isolation valve, AO220-44. This failure would have made it impossible to conduct the planned hydrogen injection test as scheduled.

After submittal, Pilgrim was shutdown for an unrelated reason, allowing containment entrance and repair of AO220-44. By telephone on April 8, 1985, Boston Edison verbally withdrew the proposed change.

This submittal is to document withdrawal of the April 4, 1985 proposed change to 3.7.D.2. Should you wish further information on this, please contact us.
