

Pursuant to the requirements set forth in Appendix A of the Limerick Generating Station Operating License, Technical Specifications, Section 6.9.1.7., we are sending you a copy of the 1984 Regional Radiological Environmental Monitoring Program No. 1 by Teledyne Isotopes and Radiation Management Corporation.

The ten day period that this report covers represents the portion of 1984 after which Limerick achieved initial criticality. The Radiological Environmental Monitoring Program confirmed that the LGS environmental effects from radioactive releases are well below the LGS Technical Specifications and applicable regulatory limits.
